Cantharellus lewisii Buyck & V. Hofstetter

Pileus 3.5-5 cm broad, convex to depressed, moist, covered with deep purple-reddish to brownish flattened scales; context 4 mm thick, odor and taste mild, dingy yellow; lamellae decurrent, close, 1-2mm broad, blunt, occasionally forking, some intervenose, lighter yellow in color than cap; stipe 4 cm long, 5-7 mm broad, \pm equal, moist, glabrous, solid, light yellowish.

Habita and habitat. Gregarious in stream bottomland hardwood forest.

Lat. general GPS 30° 42.509' N, Long. 93° 49.630' W
