Pileus 5-6 cm broad, multi caps from a single base, deeply funnelform, moist, glabrous to finely tomentose, bright orange-yellow; context up to 3 mm thick, odor fruity, dingy whitish; lamellae smooth hymenium, no ridges, dull orange; stipe 6-10 cm long, up to 2 cm broad for an individual stipe, moist, glabrous, merging into a fertile hymenium, <u>+</u>concolor cap.
