

DPL-10828

*Cantharellus altipes* Buyck & V. Hofstetter

Pileus 3-5.5 cm broad, plane with slight umbo becoming infunnelform, moist, glabrous, margin wavy to crenate, yellow to yellow-orange; context 3-4 mm thick, odor fruity, taste mild, whitish to concolor pileus; lamellae decurrent, close, 1-2 mm broad, forking and intervenose at margin, slighter lighter than pileus; stipe 3-4.5 cm long, 5-10 mm broad,  $\pm$  equal to flared at apex, moist, glabrous, solid, yellowish with rusty brown stains.

Habit and habitat. Gregarious in pine uplands with some oaks.
